Itinerary

April 9th, 2012

Today, you board your flight bound for the Washington area. You'll be assisted with your luggage and stop for dinner en route to Gettysburg where you'll check in to your hotel for the evening.
Overnight: Gettysburg Area (D)

April 10th, 2012

Eisenhower Home and Farm where the President and Mamie lived during and after their White House years. Roosevelt Memorial and the Jefferson Memorial.

Overnight: Washington DC Area (B/D)

April 14th, 2012

The parade is one of Washington DC's most beloved traditions and you'll get to see giant colorful balloons, performers and marching bands from high schools all over the

Your options include the National Museum of Natural History, The National Museum of American History, the National Gallery of Art, The National Museum of the American Indian, The United States Holocaust Memorial Museum and the Hirshhorn Museum. And of course admission is free to all. Late this afternoon, you'll return to your hotel to freshen up before enjoying dinner at a local restaurant. You'll then enjoy a guided walking tour of historic Old Town Alexandria, a charming city with a small town feel!

Overnight: Washington DC area (B/D)

April 15th, 2012

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel this morning before departing for the new September 11, 2001 Memorial at the Pentagon honoring the 184 souls who lost their lives. Your next stop will be at the National Archives where for the first time in modern history all pages of the original Declaration of Independence, Constitution and Bill of Rights are on display to the public. Next you'll visit the Smithsonian Institution's Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center - National Air and Space Museum. From the Space shuttle Enterprise to the "Enola Gay", this center tells the history of aviation and space flight. Enjoy lunch at the museum before departing for the airport and your flight home. Your time spent in Gettysburg and Washington DC enjoying the 100th Annual Cherry Blossom Festival is sure to be a lasting memory! (B)
